What's New?

The Behaviour Register has had several visual and functional updates released! The Behaviour Register is a great way for staff to quickly and efficiently record behaviour. Recording both positive and negative behaviour observed in lessons will help to reduce slip recording times and ensure that nothing gets missed.

Alongside this, we have also added the ability to bulk mark students with a click of the column header to further speed up the recording of valuable behaviour data.

Did you know?

Categories

Custom categories of students can be set up in the system for use within reports. You can group together students for focused reports where they don't share a form, class or year group. Categories can be set up by going into the School Structure section in Admin & selecting Categories. In the bottom right, you can give your category a name, once saved membership can be added by double-clicking on the name.

Behaviour Register

The Behaviour Radar is a brilliant way to view & compare behaviour data, helping to produce high level and in-depth analysis of information from slips. Within the report, there are two axis dropdowns in the top left, both of which have options to select from. Using this, you can get a variety of comparisons on behaviour data. The Axis filter can be combined with the Filter page to help break down analysis even further.
